Whereas, The New York State Council of Health-systems Pharmacists (NYSCHP) has a rich history, spanning over 64 years, and,

Whereas, NYSCHP has had many leaders who have impacted the practice of pharmacy throughout New York State and the nation, and,

Whereas, NYSCHP members of prominence have retired and left the state, or are in some cases deceased, generations of NYSCHP history are at risk of being forgotten, and,

Whereas, The NYSCHP Board of Directors have periodically appointed members to serve in the role of Historian, such a position has not been recognized as an enduring and permanent function of the Council care, therefore, be it

Resolved That:

The New York State Council of Health-system Pharmacists recognizes the role of NYSCHP Historian in the bylaws of the organization as a non-voting member of the Board of Directors. The function of the Historian will be to archive the history of the Council on the Council's website, as well as in other media formats as may be requested by the President. The Historian will be elected by the membership for two-year terms, with no term limits.
