Whereas, The Food and Drug Administration has funded the development of anticoagulation stewardship model, and,⁵

Whereas, The Veterans Health Administration has implemented national standards for anticoagulation management, and,⁶⁻⁷

Whereas, The Joint Commission has expanded the National Patient Safety Goals for anticoagulation management, and,⁸


Whereas, The National Quality Forum has developed a playbook to guide stewardship implementation; therefore, be it⁹
