**Guidelines for Submission and Selection of  
the NYSCHP REF Joe Pinto Leadership Essay  
Award**

**Essay Topic**

Please describe your most impactful leadership experience, a lesson(s) you learned from that experience and how you will use this experience to improve pharmacy practice in the future.

**Submission Process:**

- Individuals currently enrolled in a **NYS PGY1 or PGY2 residency program and New Practitioners (less than 5 years from college graduation) who are current members** are eligible to submit.
- NY State Residency Program Directors and NYSCHP membership will be emailed this document outlining the essay description and guidelines for submission the week of November 20<sup>th</sup> and repeated twice over the course of the following 3 weeks.
- **Submission Deadline:**
  - PDF copies of the essays must be submitted by email to REF Awards Committee Heide Christensen ([heide.christensen@chsli.org](mailto:heide.christensen@chsli.org)) by **Friday, January 12, 2024 @ 11:59 pm**
- **2 copies of the PDF** of the essay/references must be submitted
  - One to include the following author information:
    - Name
    - Email address
    - NYS Residency Program (if applicable)
    - NYS Residency Program Director (if applicable)
    - Graduation date and college (if applicable)
    - Mailing address
    - Telephone contact number
  - One to include the essay/references **without the author information (i.e. blinded)**

**Winning Essay will receive:**

- \$1000 award
- Recognition at the NYSCHP Annual Assembly Awards ceremony and NYSCHP REF reception
- Published in NYSCHP News Flash (upon submitting consent paperwork to [office@nyschp.org](mailto:office@nyschp.org))

**Selection Process:**

- **The winning essay will be selected by Friday, February 2, 2024**
- Essays will be judged on your ability to address the topic as outlined, as well as the overall content, writing style, justification and conclusions
- Interviews of the finalists will be conducted by the awards committee as part of the final selection process
- Winner will be contacted by the awards committee chair
- Honorable mention will be given to the next two runner-ups if applicable

**Essay Description / Instructions:**

- Review topic and any associated questions. Incorporate these concepts into an essay format.
- Essay to be 1000 word maximum
  - References are not required, but if included, will not be included in the 1000 word maximum
- The winning essay award will be presented at the NYSCHP 2024 Annual Assembly
- Essays are the property of NYSCHP

**Topic Details:**

This original essay should include:

- What your most impactful leadership experience was
- Why this experience was most impactful
- What you learned from this experience
- How you would use lessons learned in future endeavors and practice
