



 November cont.
 Print session-specific maps and locate programs of interest.
 Update CV and have it reviewed by a peer or mentor
 Order professional business cards (optional)
 December prior to session
 Orient yourself to convention center and showcase area
 - Arrive at sessions early
 - Bring notepad to take notes
 - Dress professionally

Write notes from conversations on the back of business cards you receive and reference later










PPS

- NOT a requirement








