Whereas, such professional development can maintain a pharmacist's competence in the practice of pharmacy, support achievement of practice goals, and ultimately, improve patient outcomes, therefore, be it


Resolved That:

The New York State Council of Health-system Pharmacists supports utilization of a continuing professional development (CPD) portfolio as an alternative means to fulfill the continuing education requirements for license renewal in New York State.
