

Pillars of Advocacy 2025-2027

Increase patient access to high quality health care

- Remove sunset and restrictions for pharmacist-administered vaccine or passive immunotherapies for adults and pediatrics
- Remove sunset and expand CDTM legislation
- Support CLIA-waived test and treat legislation
- Promote pharmacy services in pharmacy deserts and underserved areas
- Promote long-term viability of critical access hospitals
- Expand pharmacist administered injectable agents that promote public health

Optimize safe medication use processes

- Advocate for legislation and/or regulation that optimizes the use of technology for pharmacy operations to improve patient outcomes (e.g., artificial intelligence, etc.)
- Promote recognition of technologies used in practice that optimize safety (e.g., automation, etc.)

Promote advanced roles of the pharmacy workforce

- Allow remote supervision of pharmacy technician sterile compounding
- Promote tech-check-tech practices
- Promote legislation that ensures safe work environments

Protect the sustainability of health-system pharmacy

- Oppose restrictions on contract pharmacy
- Support legislation to defend the 340b program
- Support legislation prohibiting payer-mandated “white-” or “brown- bagging”
- Oppose payers from imposing restrictions or penalties for pharmacy services
- Support health-system access to limited distribution drugs
- Encourage policies that reduce the burden of payer prior authorization requirements
